Waste Collection Guide

REGULAR GARBAGE COLLECTED ONCE A WEEK

Limit of Four Bags (4) or Bundles per household per week

- Aerosol Cans (empty)
- Animal waste (must be bagged)
- Ashes (cold and double bagged)
- Broken glass (wrapped)
- Carbon paper, CD's
- Ceramic & clay items
- Chip bags, kitchen scraps (non compostable)
- Coffee cups / Packaging cardboard
- Decorations / Packaging Foam & Plastic
- Dog and Cat food bags, Cat Litter (bagged)
- Diapers, Dishes & Drinking glasses
- Tin Cans / Empty Milk Containers
- Plastic Bottles (laundry, window wash, detergents, etc)
- Cracker & cookie boxes (box board)
- Tissue Boxes, Towel Rolls

- Floor sweepings, Frozen juice containers
- Books, Kitchen utensils
- Latex gloves, Light bulbs/Tubes (wrapped)
- Microwave popcorn bags
- Motor oil / window wash containers (empty)
- Non recyclable packaging (cookie bags, string, wrappings)
- Toothpaste tubes
- Pots & Pans, Styrofoam
- Textiles (shoes, clothing, linen)
- Vacuum cleaner bags
- Plastic food containers
- Plastic Lids and Caps,
- Detergent boxes, pizza boxes,
- Empty food bottles/containers
- Other General Items



RECYCLING COLLECTED EVERY TWO WEEKS

No Limit to Recyclables accepted for collection every two weeks

In a Clear or Transparent Blue Bag Containers Rinsed & All Caps Must Be Removed

- Aluminum Cans
- Beverage Containers
- Glass Beverage Containers
- Plastic Beverage Containers
- Liquor & Wine Bottles
- TETRA Packs, PETE Containers
- HDPE Containers (like juice containers)



In a Separate Bag

- Clean/Dry Paper
- Catalogues
- Newspapers
- Flyers
- Phone Books
- Paperback books

Cardboard (flattened & tied)

- Appliance Boxes
- Corrugated Cardboard



ORGANICS

Why not start a compost area or bin in your backyard?

Kitchen Waste

- Fruit & Vegetable Peelings
- Coffee Grounds
- Egg Shells



Leaf & Yard Waste

- Grass Clippings, Plants, Weeds
- Branches, Straw



ALTERNATIVES TO LANDFILL

Materials not collected at the curb can be diverted through the 3R's – REDUCE, REUSE, RECYCLE

E-Waste (TV's, computers, Stereo equipment) - Store until special collection dates are announced

Oil – Bring to a local automobile service station for recycle

Tires – Bring to a motor vehicle tire retailer for recycle

Batteries – Bring to a designated collection site, such as Atlantic Recycling Inc. on Riverside Drive, in Corner Brook (634-2888)

Eye Glasses – Local churches and service groups collect used eye glasses to send to developing countries.

Used Books – Donate to a local library, flea market, charity or Used Book Store

Outdated/Unused Pharmaceuticals – Bring to a local pharmacy for disposal

Good Quality Used Clothing and Toys – Local churches and Thrift Stores collect used clothing and toys

Toxic Round Up – Watch for future Household Hazardous Waste Collection dates for Western Newfoundland
