NOISE RESOLUTION

Whereas pursuant to Section 24B of the Municipalities Act, the Council may make regulations prohibiting or regulating the blowing of horns, ringing of bells, shouting and unusual noises deemed by Council to be a nuisance to the public.

And whereas it is deemed advisable to pass a Resolution regulating noises deemed by Council to be a nuisance.

Now therefore the Town of Steady Brook Council passes and enacts the following:

1. This Resolution may be referred to as "The Town of Steady Brook Noise Resolution".
2. Noises caused by the discharge of firearms or firing or setting off, of any sort of firecrackers or fireworks is prohibited unless specifically permitted by Council and other appropriate authorities.
3. No person shall use any noise making device including that of voice, which would be heard in streets or lanes to sell wares, to solicit business, or attract attention, without first having obtained a permit from Council.
4. The Council may attach to a permit such conditions as it deems fit for the purpose of carrying out the intent of this Resolution.
5. No person shall use a motor vehicle horn or other horn any more than reasonably necessary for the safety and warning of other traffic or pedestrians.
6. No person shall, between the hours of 10 PM and 7 AM, use a lawnmower, chain saw, snowmobile, or any other machinery or equipment which is likely to disturb the peace and quiet of a neighbourhood.
7. No person shall operate a motor vehicle unless it is equipped with a muffler constructed as to prevent any intense noise.
8. No person shall cause a noise or sound by the squealing of tires or brakes of a motor vehicle caused by an unnecessarily rapid braking, turning, or setting in motion of such motor vehicle.
9. No person shall keep or permit to be kept in any building, premises or yard or any part thereof in the Municipality any dog which by reason of barking or howling is a nuisance to persons in the Municipality.
10. Nothing in this Resolution shall be deemed to prohibit the following:
 - a. The sounding of any bell, horn, siren, or other signal device on any motor vehicle, motorcycle, bicycle, or any other vehicle, or whatsoever kind, when the sounding of such signal device is required by law.
 - b. The sounding of the siren or horn on any vehicle of the Police or Fire Department or any ambulance or any public service or emergency vehicle while answering a call.
 - c. The ringing of any church bells.
 - d. The sounding of railway bells, horns, and signals.
 - e. The sounding of industrial whistles.
