

# Town of Steady Brook Recycling Information

The Town of Steady Brook has a great recycling program, with all monies going to the Gen Hansen Library. Blue boxes are available FREE of CHARGE from the Town Office. Simply, rinse all containers, remove the caps and place them in your Blue Box, at curb-side, on regular garbage day.

## INSIDE YOUR BLUE BOX



**Glass: (Food and Beverage Containers)**  
Remove all lids and caps and rinse containers. It is not necessary to remove labels.

- Clear glass, coloured glass, green glass, imported beer bottles



**Cans: (Food and Beverage Containers)**  
For sanitary reason, please rinse food and beverage containers. Cans should not be flattened.

- Soft drink cans, aluminum beer cans



### **P.E.T.E.**

(Plastic food and beverage containers identified by a number 1 in the recycling triangle) Please remove caps and rinse.

- Plastic soft drink bottles, plastic flask, mini sips, plastic drink containers



### **H.D.P.E.**

Residents can recycle High Density Polyethylene (HDPE) which is rigid plastic containers with a screw top (milk or dairy containers are not included or accepted).



- Water and juice containers, gable top containers

### **Other Information:**

- Place your Blue Box at curbside on regular garbage day
- Additional boxes are available from the Town Office
- Don't place garbage in your blue box container.
- Please keep your blue box container clean. Recycle items can be placed in a blue recycle bag to help keep your blue box clean.

## BESIDE YOUR BLUE BOX

### **FLATTEN, BUNDLE & TIE**

- Corrugated Cardboard – Remove food and liners from any boxes, such as pizza boxes, etc.
- Newspapers, magazines, flyers catalogues, telephone books, etc.
